The Firm conducts an annual certification process, requiring all legal professionals and staff to confirm that they have complied with the key quality assurance policies during the past year.

Work Intake

The Firm has a Client Screening Policy and has appointed two partners as Gatekeepers to administer that Policy. Gatekeeper approval must be obtained for all new clients and for certain new matters.
